

March Competition Night: Judge Tom Frazier

Tom Frazier and his wife were on their way to the country of Columbia. They made the stop in Modesto on their way to Sacramento. Tom is a member of the Merced Camera Club and the San Joaquin Council. Thank you, Tom for judging our digital images and prints.

Some of Tom's comments about the images he saw were that if you are doing a Nature portrait the image needs to be "tack" sharp. Likes soft background and would like to see more faces in nature. He likes to see quite a bit of detail. Challenge Travel: Should be some recognizable area. Watch the clouds if they are too bright it can distract from the image. Watch faces in deep shadow. Watch the horizon line. In Pictorial category, he likes to see photos without items cut off. Tom likes to see more clear focus in the image. Watch cropping.

February Program Night

February program night was well attended. Ed Mendes gave an excellent program. He shared his secrets on how to take good landscape photos. Ed had several very good tips for capturing that elusive photo you have always wanted to take.

Some of the things he shared with us are simple but time consuming for most average photographers. He suggests that you be familiar with the area you want to photograph. Do research on the area and go back as often as possible. There is no control over the weather so going back at different times is important. Don't be in a hurry. "Allow time for inspiration". Arrive at the location at least 1-2 hours before sunrise or sunset. Plan your shot and don't choose to many scenes in one place at the same time.

He does not use the auto mode on the camera. If you use the auto mode you are letting the "camera choose". Ed always uses a tripod when he is setting up. Check the depth of field, shutter speed, and decide what filter to use. He likes a polarizing filter. There are times when he uses a graduating filter. "Filters are important." When processing photos, use a color-calibrated environment so photos will print as you see them.

Ed uses film for his landscape art prints. All of his suggestion will work equally well for the digital photographer. Thank you, Ed for sharing.
