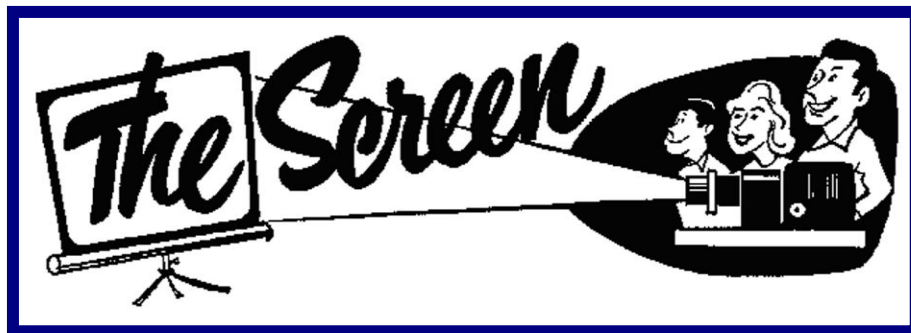

On **November 7th** (Competition Night) you will need to have your **End of Year** prints and the **President Award** prints for Renis.

By **November 11th** Renis needs to have the **digital image entries** along with the **digital image for the prints** you will be submitting. He needs the digital image of the print in order to put together a slide show for the dinner.

End of Year images are based on the following criteria:

1. The images must have been used in competition for the year 2011. (Including November)

2. You may enter two images in the each of the following categories: **Prints** (due November 7th), **Digital Nature, and Digital Color** (due November 11th).
3. Special End of Year category is **HUMOR**. This category can be anything, and it did not need to be used for competition this year. You may enter two images for this category. (due November 7th)
4. **PRESIDENTS AWARD** – Enter only **one** image. It can be anything and did not have to be used in competition this year. The image may be a print or digital. If it is a **print**, please supply a digital copy for Renis to include in the slide show. **Print** is due November 7th and the **digital image** is due November 11th.
